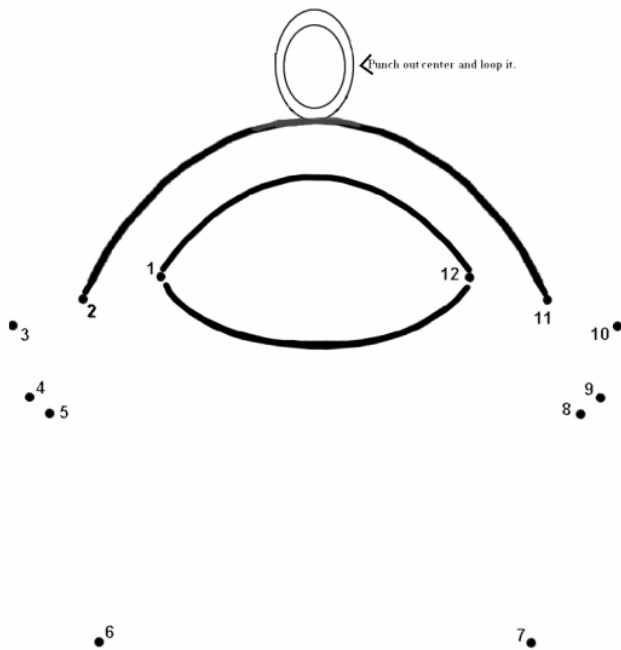

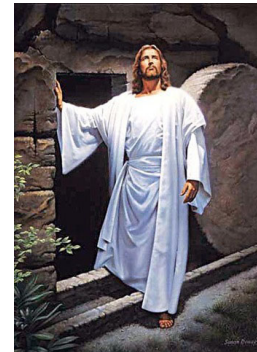

Easter Craft - Stained Glass Eggs

Materials: Contact paper, tissue paper, googly eyes, safety scissors, and yarn

Directions: Give the kids the contact paper to cut out as an Easter Egg. Then let them make their own stained glass egg by gluing tissue paper to the contact paper. After they have dried hang them in the window to make a beautiful stained glass look.



Easter Recipe – Jelly Bean Carrots

Ingredients: Clear icing bags found at most craft stores, orange jelly beans, green tissue paper, twist ties, and scissors

Directions: Fill icing bag with jelly beans, leaving about 3 inches at the top. Cut out two 8-inch squares of green tissue paper, lay one atop the other. Twist them in the middle to make carrot tops. Place the twisted part of the tissue into the bag and use the twist tie to secure the bag shut.
