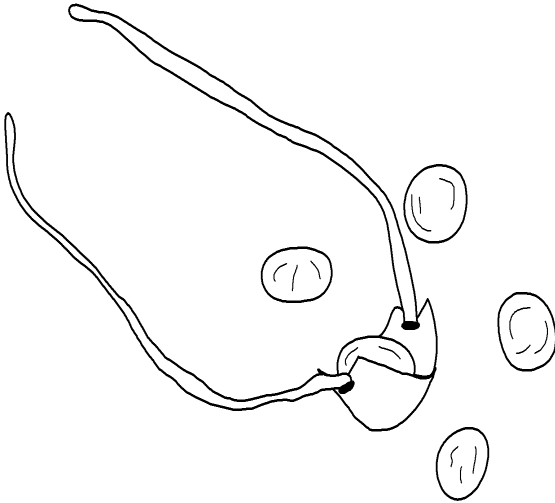


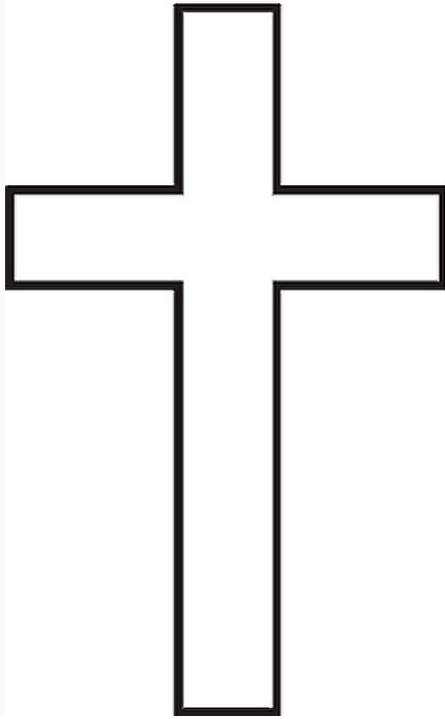

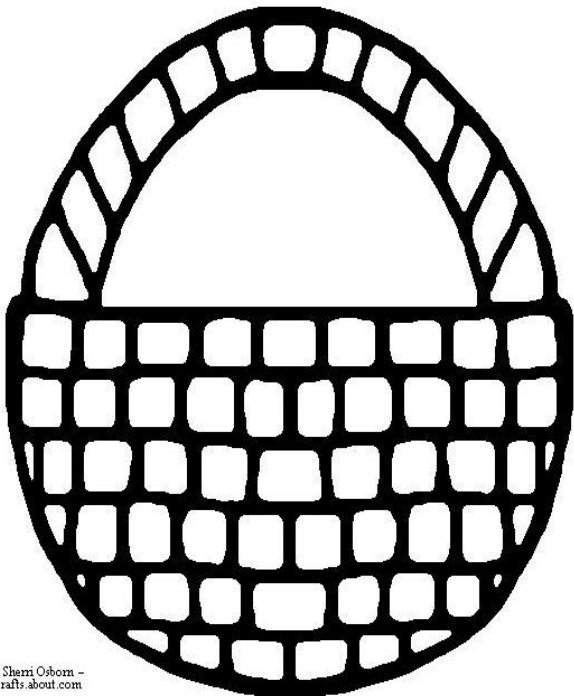

into our hands.**

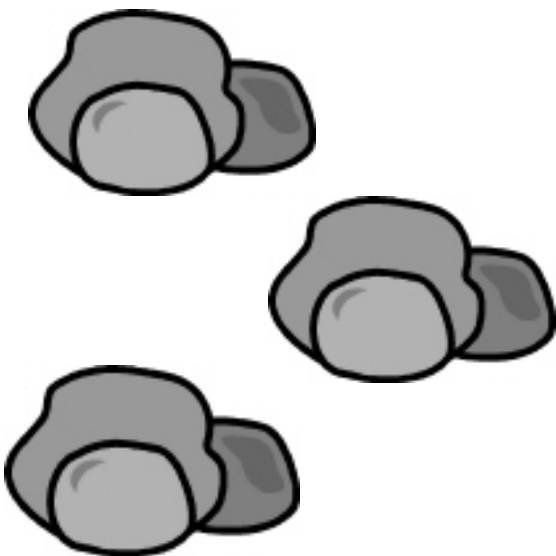
David – Place on inside left flap panel
