Take-Home Sheet for Parents

What Your Child Learned this Week:

God chose Joshua to lead the people of Israel into the Promised Land. The first city to be conquered was Jericho. God told the people to march around the city once every day for seven days. On the final day, they marched around the walls seven times. Joshua told the trumpets to sound, the people shouted, and the walls fell down!

What I Can Do at Home With my Child:

Practice this memory verse with your child:

**“When the trumpet sounded, the people shouted, and the wall collapsed.”~
Joshua 6: 20**

Discuss these ideas with your child:

What did Jericho have all the way around it?

How many days did the people march around Jericho?

What do you think it felt like to watch the walls fall down?

Family Fun:
